


Tripura Current Affairs 1st to 7th February

☐ The Tripura Fish Festival 2024 got underway in Agartala today. The Purbasha Complex in the state capital of Agartala is the venue for the two-day celebration.



- ❖ Since 2019, the Ministry of Fisheries of the Tripura government has been organizing the festival.
- ❖The annual celebration is viewed as a venue to support Tripura's fishing sector and provide the state's fishermen with tools to increase their market share both inside and outside the state.
- ❖ Tripura, the northeastern hilly state of India, produced 82 thousand metric tons of fish during fiscal year 2022, which was a slight increase from financial year 2020.



☐ Assam Rifles Land: Union and Tripura governments resolve their dispute; the Supreme Court dismisses the lawsuit.



- ❖ The Union of India and the State of Tripura have a land dispute called the Assam Rifles Ground. Today, February 2, the Apex Court was notified that the parties had reached a settlement.
- ❖ As a result, the case was resolved by the Division Bench of Justices Hrishikesh Roy and Prashant Kumar Mishra. Importantly, the Assam Rifles hold possession of the land.
- ❖ As per the terms of this settlement, the Government of Tripura will be allowed to hold Ceremonial Functions, the Republic Day Parade, Independence Day Celebrations, etc. and other important functions or events on this ground.
- ❖ Necessary correction in the Revenue records in the name of Assam Rifles will have to be made within three months.



☐ Fake PRTC rackets were so prevalent in nearly every state SDM office that PA to SDM (Teliamura) was suspended.



- ❖ Tripura appears to be overflowing with fictitious PRTCs these days, as a large number of foreigners are flooding the state and obtaining fictitious PRTCs in exchange for large payments to corner jobs that were initially intended for unemployed youth in Tripura.
- ❖ It came to the notice that people from outside Tripura is taking PRTC to get job in Tripura.



☐ Three citizens of Myanmar are charged by the NIA in a global human trafficking case.



- ❖ Three citizens of Myanmar are the subject of a chargesheet filed by the National Investigation Agency (NIA) in connection with a significant global human trafficking investigation.
- ❖ The unlawful activity centers on the unauthorized entry and transportation of foreign individuals, predominantly Rohingya, into India via the border between Bangladesh and India.
- ❖ They are all permanent residents of Myanmar's Maungdaw district, the agency said.



☐ In the North district of Tripura, CM Manik Saha allots 15 acres for a new cancer hospital.



- ❖ Dr. Saha expressed his satisfaction with the Atal Bihari Regional Cancer Hospital's (ABRCH) excellent performance while announcing the approval of a proposal to give 15 acres of land for the construction of a new cancer hospital to eminent oncologist Dr. R Ravi Kannan, the director of the Cachar Cancer Hospital and Research Centre (CCHRC).
- ❖ The land will be given away for free with the intention of bringing high-quality cancer care to the North District, which will help communities like Unakoti.



☐ The Tripura Education Board permits students to write in Roman or Bengali on their Kokborok language paper.



- ❖ Dr. Dhananjay Gan Chowdhury, the President of the Tripura Board of Secondary Education (TBSE), announced today that students will have the option to write the Kokborok subject exams in either Bengali or Roman script for the upcoming board exams.
- ❖ This decision comes after a series of protests by various indigenous student groups demanding the option to write board exams in Roman Script for the Kokborok language subject.



☐ Tripura will soon have two testing labs for organic farming: Minister of Agriculture



- ❖ In a move to boost organic farming in Tripura, Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare Minister Ratan Lal Nath announced on Wednesday that the state government has decided to establish two new organic farming research institutes in the state.
- Research on five different crop types is also being done at the Seed Research Center in Arundhatinagar.
- ❖ The state also has a sophisticated system for testing soil, which allows decisions about cultivation to be made based on knowledge of the nature of the soil.
- ❖Over 3000 seeds have been tested in the last three years, and 1.73 lakh soil samples have been tested in the last six years.
